My work explores the intersections of fragility, labour, and transformation, using unconventional materials such as silk, sugar, and found objects to challenge traditional techniques. Featured in leading publications including *Frieze*, *Sotheby's Made in Bed*, *BBC One*, and *Saatchi's Rising Stars*, with commissions from BBC One and Tate & Lyle. Alongside my studio practice, I am a passionate and dynamic Fine Art and History of Art educator with over 10 years of experience.
